



2022 PARSONS GREEN SQUASH CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. The 2022 Parsons Green Squash Championship Tournament is open only to the Club members. You must be eligible to play squash for The Parsons Green Sports & Social Club, i.e. you don't play squash for another county team;
- 2. Entries close on Wednesday the 11th January 2023 and are to be made using the Club's MyCourts booking system;
- 3. The tournament is scheduled to happen during Saturday the 21st January only;
- 4. Entry Fee £ 15 to be paid in advance throughout the Club's MyCourts platform;
- 5. Any withdrawals must be notified as soon as possible, withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded.
- 6. An interval of 1 hour in between matches will prevail unless there is an understanding between players and with the organisation approval, for the match to happen earlier than the previous mentioned resting time. Semi-finals and Finals times can't be changed.
- 7. In by an unfortunate situation, a player reports any condition or injury that restrains him to proceed with the following match on the scheduled time, it will lead to a walkover to the opponent;
- 8. Each game is played in the Point-a-rally scoring (PARS) to 11 points. The player who scores 11 points first wins the game, except when the score reaches 10-all, the game continues until one player leads by 2 points. Either player may score points, the server, on a winning rally, scores a point and retains the service; the receiver, on a winning rally, scores a point and becomes the server.
- 9. Player who fails to arrive within 15 minutes after the start of the match will be considered as conceding a walkover to the opponent, with a score of 11-0, 11-0, 11-0.
- 10. All matches of the Main Draw are played the best out of 5 games and matches of Golden Plate the best out of 3 games.
- 11. Players defeated on the qualifying round and 1st round of the Main Draw will be entered into the Golden Plate.
- 12. The winner of each match must mark the following match on the same or other court as requested by the tournament organiser.
- 13. England Squash rules for conduct apply
- 14. The finals will be marked by a qualified referee.
- 15. The official Squash Ball will be the Dunlop Squash Ball (Double Yellow Dots)
- 16. The organizer WILL NOT be responsible for any loss of property or injury sustained during the duration of the event.
